Letters from the military families are sent, routinely, expressing their thanks and appreciation. Joseph Anania, Director of Troopons stopped by to give his thanks to the group. Joe is a WWII veteran and a member of our lodge. The group may change from week to week, but their sole purpose is to continue to support our military by dedicating their time to this worthwhile program.


