For the past three years, members of the lodge come together for 2-3 hours every afternoon to sort coupons for military families, serving abroad to be used in the many commissaries. Each week, John Georgoudiou, Coordinator of the Troopons Program, sits down with the group to sort new and expired coupons by food groups, baby products, household and pet products, and more. They sort 15-20 pounds of coupons, each week, with boxes weighing 10 pounds each, at a dollar value of \$35 - \$50,000. Just recently, the group was informed they sorted 1,087.75 pounds of coupons and the program got a donation of 500 pounds of cookies from Figi. Letters from the military families are sent, routinely, expressing their thanks and appreciation. Joseph Anania, Director of Troopons stopped by to give his thanks to the group. Joe is a WWII veteran and a member of our lodge. The group may change from week to week, but their sole purpose is to continue to support our military by dedicating their time to this worthwhile program.
